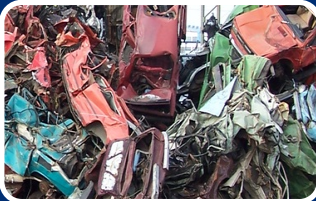

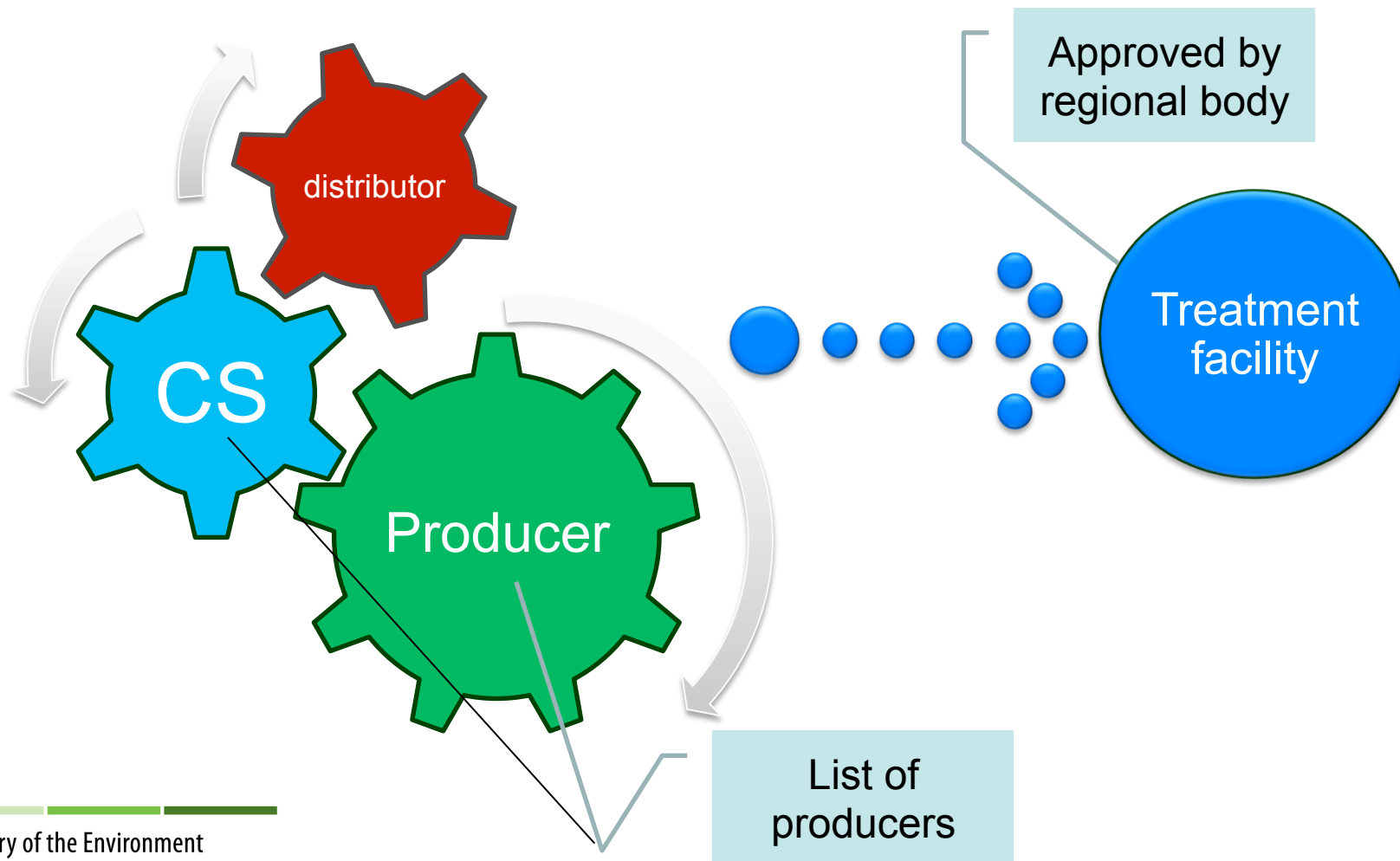

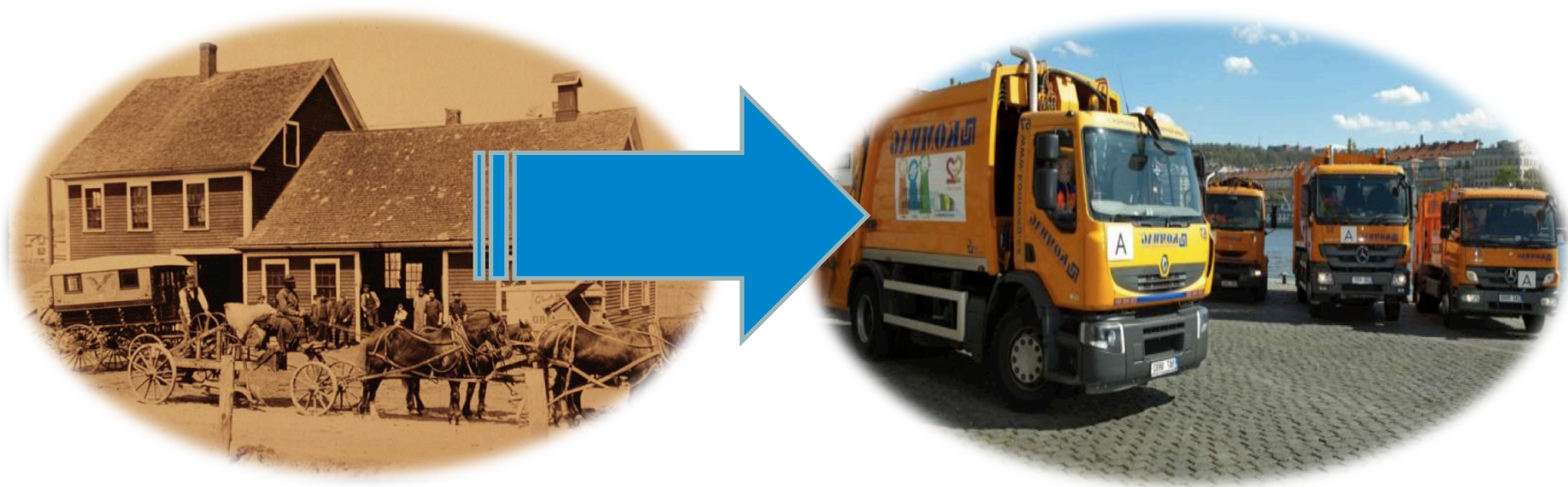

National specifications

1. Collective schemes establish own network of take back locations, collection facilities and treatment facilities
2. Fiction of law - The product taken back shall become waste at the moment it is handed over to a person authorised for its recovery or disposal
3. The sole collective system provides for financing of historical WEEE in each category of EEE

4. Large equipment



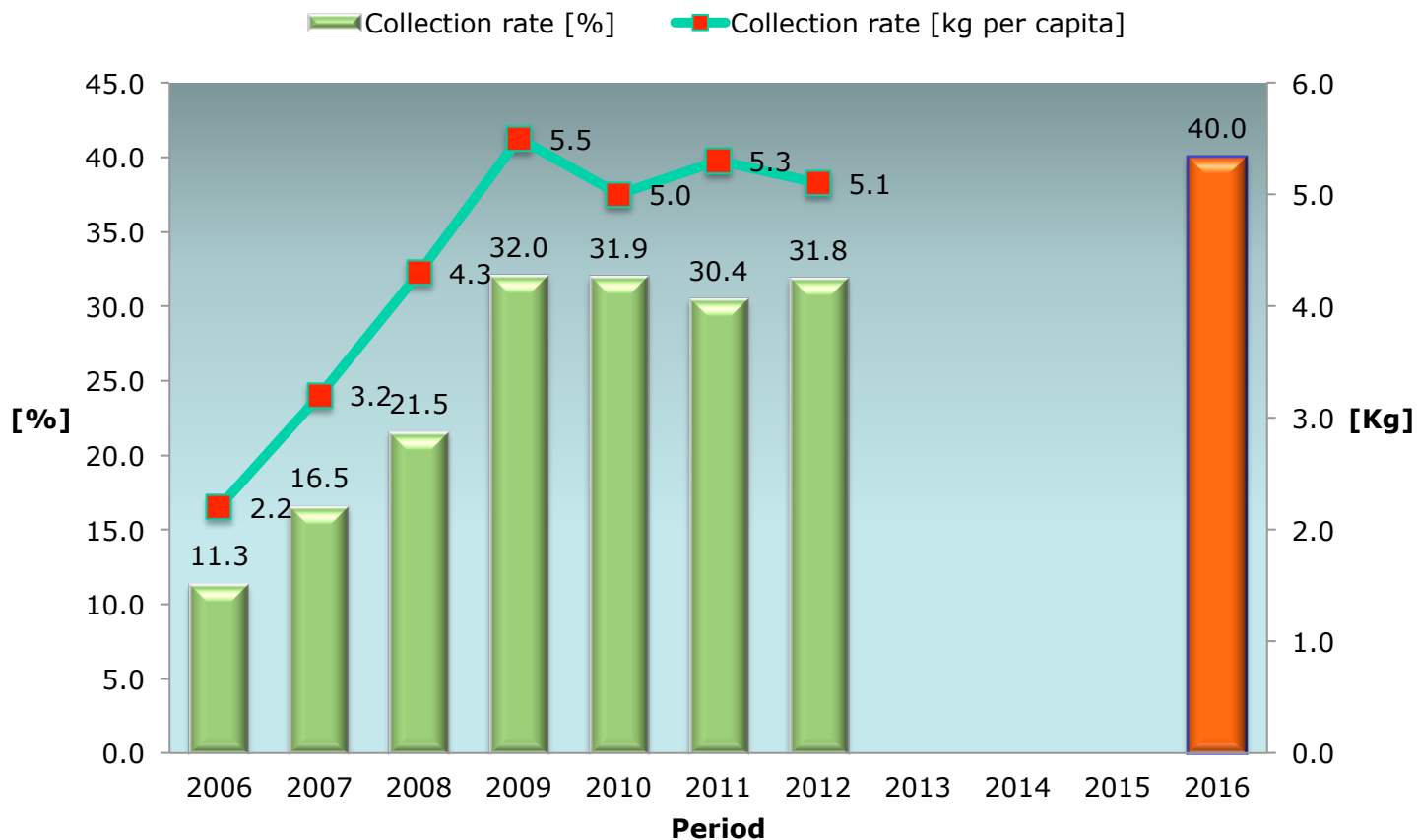

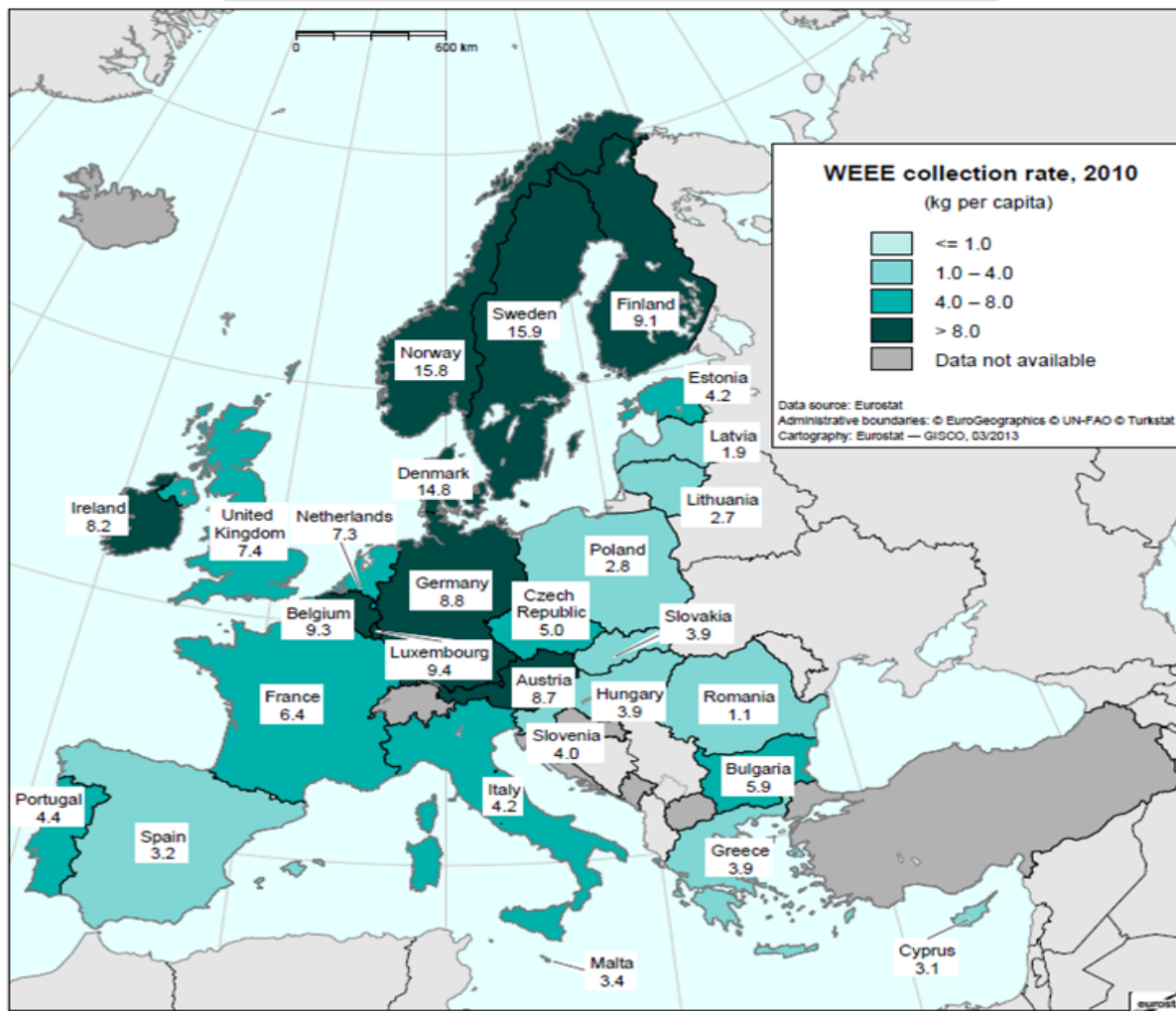
Annual reports of producers

- through ISPOP – Integrated system for reporting obligations
- deadline: 31st of March – directly to agency CENIA

ISOH – Information system of Waste management

- obligated person: waste producers, authorised persons for collection, recovery and disposal
- reporting in accordance with European List of waste
- through ISPOP to municipalities
- deadline: 15th of February

Results of WEEE collection



Enforcement of take back and recovery obligations



- **The Czech Environmental Inspectorate**
 - Institution under management of Ministry of Environment
 - Check the WEEE obligations
- **The Czech Trade Inspectorate**
 - Institution under management of Ministry of Trade, Check RoHS



Upcoming changes of Waste Act

- Dividing Waste Act No. 185/2001 Coll. into two/ four parts – under discussion
 - **Waste Act** (waste management rules, obligations for waste producers)
 - **Used Product Collection Act** (take back and recovery/recycling of WEEE, batteries, tyres, ELV) – possible dividing into four parts is under discussion
