





Collection and Transportation Work




Collection and transportation of solid municipal waste is being implemented by **Baku City Executive Power**

Landfill - The Rehabilitation of Balakhani Landfill



- Organization of waste acceptance and utilization in proper manner;
- Prevention of adverse affects to the environment;
- Development of internal and external infrastructure/communications;



The Rehabilitation of Balakhani Landfill



- Establishing of security and safety systems;
- Creation of new job places;
- Protection of public health.





«The Integrated Solid Waste Management» Project



Project components:

- Institutional support and capacity building;
- Rehabilitation and management of the Balakhani landfill;
- Rehabilitation of closure of other dumps sites;
- Procurement of waste management equipment;
- Technical preparation of post project investments.




- Commissioning date: December 19, 2012

Material recovery - Sorting Line (Material Recovery Facility)



Project goals:

 To increase segregation of municipal waste and develop recycling business

Annual capacity: 200,000 tons





Sorting Line (Material Recovery Facility)



Key benefits:

- Reduction of negative impact to environment;
- Saving in natural resources and energy;
- Reusable and cheap raw material market;
- Reduction of final waste volume;
- New job places;





Balakhani Eco-Industrial Park



Project goals:

 To support recycling businesses, attract foreign investments, transfer of best practices

Area size: 7 ha





Balakhani Eco-Industrial Park



Key benefits:

- Providing an integrated infrastructure in one location;
- Reduction of negative impact to environment;
- Establishment of recycling/reuse and production facilities;
- Market access for the sale of the obtained raw material or produced goods.
